## Treasurer's Report:

The budget for the 2013-2014 school year was presented and distributed at this meeting.
We had $\$ 1100$ in the checking account. Moved $\$ 14,000$ from savings account to the checking account for startup this year.

Motion made by Keri Pattison to approve the 2013-2014 school year budget with changes. Second by Andrea Milnar. All in favor. Budget approved.
-Changes to budget: Move Family Fun Day down to PTO Run Projects, add $\$ 100$ back to restricted fund that paid for Sunshine, increase storage unit amount to $\sim \$ 550$.
